

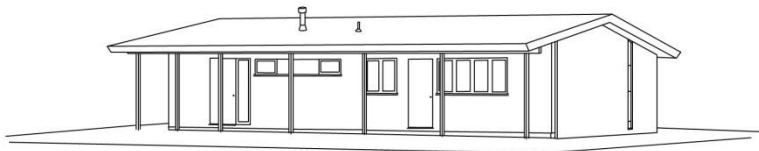


HISTORY OF RESURRECTION EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH

On August 1, 1891, W.W. Hays and his wife Juliet platted the land they owned so that a town could begin. For nearly 60 years, Haysville remained a 2-square-block of houses, businesses, and a Methodist and a Christian Church.

In the 1950's the town began a period of rapid growth and in 1957, the United Lutheran Church in America sent Leo and Wilma Nielsen to Haysville as mission developers.

The first services of Resurrection Lutheran Church were held Sunday, June 30, 1957, in the basement of the parsonage at 609 West Grand. Sunday School classes began two weeks later on July 14.



The House Chapel at 134 South German Street was dedicated on Sunday, March 15, 1959, with Dr. Alfred Young, President of the Central States Synod, preaching

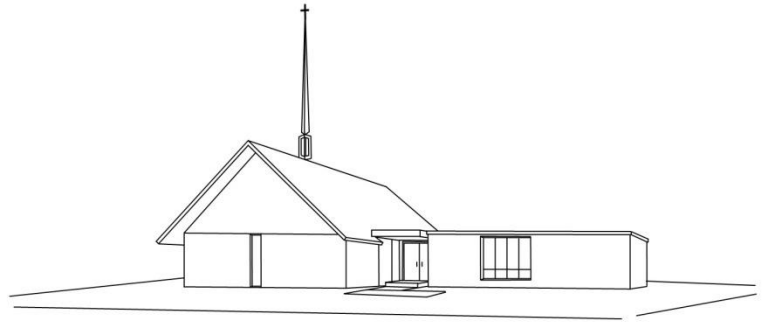
at the 11:00 a.m. service and Dr. Reno R. Frobenius, assistant to the synod president and Superintendent of Missions, preaching at the afternoon service.

Resurrection Evangelical Lutheran Church of Haysville, Kansas, was formally established on Sunday, May 3, 1959, in an organizational service officiated by the Reverend Dr. Reno R. Frobenius, President of the Central States Synod of the United Lutheran Church in America. The order for the organization was conducted at 11:00 a.m. in the House Chapel.

The first congregational meeting was held that same evening at 7:00 p.m. in the House Chapel with 28 members of the congregation present. The group adopted Articles of Incorporation, a Constitution and By-laws, elected nine members to the church council, and issued a call to Rev. Leo R. Nielsen, the Mission Developer of the congregation, to serve as its first pastor. The congregation was officially incorporated by the State of Kansas on May 21, 1959.

Sixty-four people are listed in the parish register as charter members. The first council prior to the formal organization included Herbert Bauer, Arthur Bissell, Donald Beason, James Brown, Wayne Clark, George Dhority, Thomas Gregory, Jimlee Kemper, Ted Moody, Dwain Schmidt, Virgil Schmidt, Harold Smith, and George Swanson.

The dreams of the congregation were realized when on July 21, 1968, the new church building at 521 West Grand was dedicated. A guiding force in reaching this milestone was the pastor, C. Arthur Freeberg. The sermon for the dedication was preached by Dr. N. Everett Hedeem, President of the Central States Synod, Lutheran Church in America.



As the years passed, the congregation saw the need to find a new site and to build a new church. This goal was realized on December 18, 2005,

when we gathered our hymnals and followed the processional cross to our new church at 3850 W 71st South. The doors were unlocked and the congregation followed the processional cross into the sanctuary for the worship service.

The formal dedication of the new church was held on Reformation Sunday, October 29, 2006, with Bishop Gerald Mansholt of the Central States Synod present.

Called pastors who have served Resurrection are Leo R. Nielsen, 1959-1963; Paul Rowoldt, 1964-1966; C. Arthur Freeberg, 1966-1973; Jonathan K. Jensen, 1974-1976; Daniel Swenson, 1979-1989. Alfred W. Lindberg, a retired pastor, served as our supply pastor from 1989 until 1996. The congregation determined to again call a full-time pastor and issued a call to C Timothy Leaf has served as our pastor from 1996 to the present.

Presently the congregation includes 122 confirmed active communing members with a baptized membership of 181. We enjoy a wide range of age groups with young families predominant, small group ministries, active committees and youth groups, and dedicated volunteers. To accommodate the increased worship attendance, a second Sunday morning service was added in September, 1997.
